THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE CARLISLE AREA)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (NO.3) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Cumbria Highways to carry out carriageway patching works (“the Works”), the County Council of Cumbria intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the lengths of road specified in the attached Schedule.

Suitable diversion routes will be indicated on site by the display of relevant traffic signs as and when the temporary closures are in force.

Phased works will not necessarily be done in numerical order.

Cumbria Highways will ensure that local residents and the general public are informed of which roads are to be closed and when, nearer the time.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

Plans showing the locations and details of the alternative routes are available for public inspection at the offices of Cumbria Highways, The Parkhouse Building, Kingmoor Business Park, Carlisle, CA6 4SJ or Tel: 0300 303 2992. Please quote the reference CACH48.

The Order will come into operation on 8 May 2018 and may continue in force for a period of up to eighteen months from that date as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for approx. **3 months in total.**

SCHEDULE

EXTENT OF RESTRICTIONS AND ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

1. C1015 Harker, Carlisle

From its junction with C1022 extending in a westerly direction for a distance of approx.1.8km.

Alternative route: via C1016, A689 and C1022.

2. C1016 Rockcliffe, Carlisle

From its junction with the C1015 extending in an overall north westerly direction for a distance of approx.1.6km.

Alternative route: via C1016, C1022 and C1015.

3. C1041 Brisco, Carlisle

From its junction with the C1014 extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of approx.2.5km.

Alternative route via: the unrestricted section of the C1041, Lamb Street and the C1037.

4. U1181 Eden Golf Course, Carlisle

From its junction with Eden Golf Course extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of approx.1.6km.

Alternative route via: the unrestricted sections of the U1181, A689 and C1013.

5. C1013 Irthington, Carlisle

From its junction with the A689 extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx.4km.

Alternative route via: the A6071, C1046 and A689.

6. C1012 Lynholmeford, Carlisle

From its junction with the B6318 extending in an overall south easterly direction for a distance of approx.3.3km.

Alternative route via: C1012, C1030, A6071, C1013 and B6318.
